

# SUSTAINABILITY

Richloom places environmentally and socially responsible practices at the center of the company's mission.

At our warehouse in the South Carolina, over **75%** of the corrugated cardboard used for retail packaging, tubes, and shipping samples is recycled. We reuse pallets, tubes, yarn cones, and encourage customers to recycle memos once the design process is complete.

At Richloom Weaving in High Point, NC, our production process is completed in the Southeast - the majority within a 100-mile radius of the mill itself. We have **zero** yarn waste; every yarn purchased ends up woven into a fabric.

For our outdoor collections, **100%** of the yarns we use are solution-dyed, virtually using no water during the manufacturing process of both yarn and fabric. We aim to weave with more recycled yarns, increase the number of solution-dyed yarns used, and adopt a more environmentally friendly C0 finish.
